Additionally, lubrication may be needed to inhibit rust and corrosion, to carry away heat, and to cushion impact forces. The lack of proper lubrication can cause several serious problems. When a chain is in need of lubrication, wear from one joint to another can vary greatly, causing erratic action. Rapid joint wear can cause early loss of timing in a conveyor. Lack of lubrication can increase friction and power consumption and cause a temperature rise. In some cases lack of lubrication can lead to chain seizure and become non-repairable. Proper lubrication is critical to the overall longer life of the chain. With the recommended automatic lubricator you can achieve these results and more:
